Spring Term 2 2023

How can we care for animals in our world?

Rationale: This topic will be an introduction to how we are responsible for looking after animals we share our planet with. Through this we can begin to connect hot and cold climates with natural and man-made features.

PE lessons will be on Wednesday and Friday. Please make sure all items of clothes are clearly named.

KASE Our curriculum is designed to ensure the children build their knowledge whilst having opportunities to develop important attributes like teamwork and empathy. We plan for a clear progression of skills and provide a wealth of experiences to further their engagement and understanding. We therefore call this our **KASE** curriculum.

Music

As a class we will begin to learn the difference between tempo and dynamics. Pupils will explore how tempo and dynamics can be controlled through playing percussion instruments.

English

During this term in our English, we will begin by looking at features of information text and the difference between fiction and non-fiction. We will focus on finding out 'All about Hedgehogs' and we will write our own informative fact file.

Also, the class will be learning how to write instructions. We will begin with looking at how to follow instructions, which 'bossy' words we will need and how to order them using appropriate time words. This will lead to us writing our own set of instructions.

Art

This term we will learn to tear, cut and snip mediums, to use lines of contrasting and muted colour. We will then move on to working in the style of the artist Paul Klee.

Science and Geography

To become inquisitive scientists, this term we will revisit looking at animals -with a special focus on hedgehogs. To become geographers, this term we will be learning about hot and cold locations including human and physical features.

PE.

In outdoor games we will practise skills such as bouncing and catching to develop our fundamental ball skills. During our gymnastics sessions, we will be balancing using the apparatus and developing some confidence with jumping on and off the apparatus.

PSHE/ Thrive

We will learn about what we put inside and onto our bodies and how these make us feel and why we need these remedies to make us feel better.

Maths

In Maths we will be measuring and comparing the length of objects and be introduced to centimetres and metres. We will also develop our knowledge and skills of recognising a range of coins and notes. We will then be working on multiplication and division using the words; 'lots of' and 'shared between'. We will be looking at a range of 2D and 3D shapes. Also, Year One will describe positions and direction with movement of half, quarter and three-quarter turns.

Computing

In our Computing lessons we will be introducing pupils to collecting data and information. They will focus on how to group and label information so that they can use computers to present their data.

RE

Judaism will be our focus during RE sessions. We will learn about traditions, festivals and stories from the Jewish faith.
